Time:	Destination/Activities	Approximate Driving Time or Length of Activity
7:30am	Geomatics and Native Studies classes Depart CDCS for Tobermory. One stop in Tara to pick up a few students on the way.	1 hour, 40 min.
9:10-9:30am	Arrival at Bruce Peninsula National Park Visitor Centre (Tobermory) – Drop off Native Studies class. Class has self-orientation of facility and a presentation. (90 min.)	Native Studies Class at Visitor centre for 90 min. Native Studies class
9:25am	Geomatics class departs for Marine Operations Centre (close to lighthouse near Big Tub Harbour)	~5 min. from visitor centre
9:30am	Geomatics class arrives at Marine Operations Centre	60-90 min. length
11:00am	Geomatics class departs Marine Operations Centre for Johnstone Fields Site – Hidden Valley Road Bus Dropoff. Geomatics class is at this site for the next 4-5 hours and bus is not needed.	20 min. South of Tobermory – Hidden Valley Road accessible from Highway 6 Class at field site for 4-5 hours
11:00am-12:10pm	Native Studies class walks to downtown Tobermory from Visitor's Centre and has time for lunch	~1 hour
11:30am	Bus returns to Tobermory (Harbour area) to pick up Native Studies Class	20 min. back to Tobermory
12:10pm	Native Studies class departs Tobermory for Cameron Lake	10 minutes (~10 km)
12:30pm-2:30pm	Native Studies class arrives at Cameron Lake for Medicine Walk	2 hours
2:30pm	Native Studies class is picked up and heads to Johnstone field site OR Crane River Park area (within a few minutes of each other)	10 min. drive from Cameron Lake to Crane River Park
Between 3:30 and 4:00pm	Bus picks up Geomatics students at Johnstone Fields Site and departs for CDCS. **Stop in Tara to let some students off.	1 hour and 20 minutes (Johnstone Fields to CDCS)
5:30pm	Arrival at CDCS
